The role of the neurology specialist nursing team:

Neurology nurses are trained nurses who have additional specialist knowledge and skills in neurology.

This allows them to provide support and advice for people living with multiple sclerosis, motor neurone disease, Parkinsons, Parkinsons-plus syndromes, as well as patients' families and carers.

The team consists of two community neurology nurse practitioners and four community neurology nurses.

The team can provide:

- More information on your condition for you, your family and other professionals
- Advice on managing symptoms
- Support and guidance with medication and therapies
- Support to you and hospital staff if you need an admission

How the service is delivered:

- Telephone advice line
- · Nurse-led clinics
- Home visits for housebound patients

Telephone advice line

This is not an emergency telephone line; if your query is urgent, please contact your GP or telephone the 111 service.

If your question is in relation to your neurologist appointment, please contact the James Paget University Hospital's Neurology department on **01493 453937**.

Our advice line number is 01493 809977.

You will need to give the telephone operator a brief description of your question or problem.

A number of telephone appointments for a neurology nurse to call back for advice will be available daily.

The telephone operator will give you an appointment time for the nurse to ring you back. If there is no answer they will make two more attempts, then you will need to ring again.

The nurse will endeavour to call at the appointed time but in the case of unavoidable circumstances, there may be a delay.

If the allocated appointment slots have been taken, you will be offered the next available appointment.



We will only ever pass on information about you if there are other people involved in your care, or if there is a genuine need for it.

We will not disclose your information to others without your permission unless there are exceptional circumstances.
